Each Mug Rug will be 5" by 8" so that's plenty of space for a mug of something warm & comforting along with a sweet or savory treat.

These are fun to make and personalize. They are also pretty quick to make so you will definitely get 1 complete and maybe several more. They are also addictive so you won't make just 1!

Supply List – Definitely the shortest list ever!!

- Scissors, suitable for cutting fused fabric
- Pencil
- Small cutting mat & rotary cutter maybe share
- Small cutting Ruler (6 ¹/₂" by 12 ¹/₂" maybe)
- Materials, as below

Each Mug rug needs:

- 1 piece of fabric for back of Mug Rug @ 6" by 9"
 - I chose a different colour for each as I want to give these to family & friends at Christmas
- 1 piece of batting @ 6" by 9"
 - Linda is bringing a big Ikea bag full of batting scraps to use!
- 1 piece of foundation fabric @ 7" by 10"
 - A little bit bigger so you can trim after collage it will be covered completely so anything works!!
- Several small pieces of fabric to use for collage
 - This will be background for your top so probably should be collection of analogous colours.
 - That lets you choose a very different colour for the additional design on top
 - Square or rectangular cuts will be easier to add to fusible.


