Webinar (MQG) with Riane Menardi Morrison, “Cropping and Scaling”

Full Guild Workshop {What’s that mean?} **Free for Members**

– “What If I Play With This Pattern?”

Inspired by Riane’s webinar, we will be playing with choices of traditional, relatively easy block constructions. You will receive a packet of traditional block shapes to play with and recreate into your original layout. Then we will learn how to use this to create your own pattern dimensions.

You then will have time to translate your pattern to fabric. You will need to bring 3 pieces of fabric, preferably solids so you can focus on the graphic design. Choose a background {1M}, main design colour {1 M}, and a small accent colour {scrap about ¼ M}

We will provide the Freezer Paper, oversized Graph Paper, and some sample patterns so you can have a hands-on experience with Nicole’s methods. Learn how to up-scale your pattern on oversized graph paper. Then learn how to transfer this to freezer paper and then to fabric.

You could also make your own small pattern and use the method to up-scale your own templates.

You can create your own designed fabric. Mary will show some of her printed examples and demonstrate how to print leaves on fabric and help you create your own designs.
